

Do you think a visit to the veterinarian is all about the shots?

Vaccinations provide important protection for your kitten. But, in addition to the vaccines that control viruses and bacterial diseases, your regular visits assure early detection of other illnesses that can be even more important in extending your pet's life. Only a doctor's physical exam and diagnostic testing can identify these conditions at the early stages when cure or reversal is most successful. If you wait for obvious signs, it may be too late.

Outstanding care and nutrition has increased the average life span of our pets. It's no longer true that one year is like seven "pet years." In fact, if you think about it, the first year of your kitten's life is more like being fifteen or sixteen. After adolescence, your kitten ages more slowly, more like 4-5 "cat years" per calendar year. At this rate, it's even more important to maintain routine annual exams for your cat.

Kitten Complete Program

This program is designed for kittens that are going to be inside only cats and consists of four monthly visits: each visit your kitten will be vaccinated, a stool sample checked, and wormed for round and hookworms. We'll also check the progress of litter box training and help prevent any behavioral issues before they start. This program also includes Feline AIDS and Leukemia testing, a urinalysis, along with consults on nutrition and behavior, and unlimited office calls during regular business hours. It also includes spay or neuter.

Kitten Explorer Program

This plan is for kittens that are going to be both indoors and outdoors. It is just like our Kitty Care program, with the addition of Feline Leukemia vaccination and Feline AIDS vaccination. It does include having your kitten spayed or neutered, and unlimited office calls during regular office hours.
